BCC voted in favor of the proposal.

Bog bridge washed out. May be reusable

Trees down in stream but non on trails

Erosion worsened and corrective measures will be determined. Plantings, adding a trail, and rerouting were discussed

Coastal Rivers is very involved in assessing and planning needed maintenance

Gravel washed out behind fire station. Need more information.

### Plantings at HOC

Ann and Kerry have plans to plant several red dogwoods along bank to help prevent erosion

Adding native shrubs in other areas and planting milkweed and other native flowering plants in the large field. Vervine and Blue flag iris will also be planted
