

**TOWN OF BREMEN
SELECTMEN'S MEETING MINUTES
VIA ZOOM AND IN-PERSON
July 2, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.**

The meeting was called to order at 5:02 p.m.

Chairperson Pieh read the appointment listing for the 2024-2025 terms, a copy of this listing is attached to the minutes.

On a motion duly made by Select Chair Pieh and seconded by Selectman Marsh, the Board of Selectmen unanimously (3-0) to approve the list of appointments.

Melanie Pendleton, Town Clerk then reviewed the two bills that have been received for the cost of out sourcing the printing and mailing of the revaluation letter that the Assessing Agent had Done. The cost of the two items was \$780.64 thus the request to authorize the transfer from the Revaluation Reserve Account in that amount.

On a motion duly made by Select Chair Pieh and seconded by Selectman Marsh, the Board of Selectmen unanimously (3-0) to approve the transfer of \$780.64 from the Revaluation Reserve Account.



Chairperson Pieh addressed the revaluation letter that was sent out to the taxpayers with Selectman Marsh stating that there was a Special Selectmen Meeting on Wednesday, June 26. At this meeting both himself and Selectman Page spoke with Jim Murphy, the Assessing Agent, to inform him of the Board being is disagreement with the handling of the process. The Selectmen are working to ensure that the concerns of residents/tax payers of the town are being heard and addressed.

On a motion duly made by Select Chair Pieh and seconded by Selectman Marsh, the Board of Selectmen unanimously (3-0) to approve the minutes of June 20, 2024 and warrants June 28 & 30, 2024.
